Additional comments:

Thesis goal and objectives are clearly stated (good); logics and structure of the paper are good (but Methodology and Data analysis chapters have the same numeration 3); thoroughness of the content is satisfactory; the text has necessary features for scientific research; results of the thesis are satisfactory, could be qualified as a basis for an additional quantitative research; literature review is good.

The qualitative part of the thesis (chapter 1) is rather strong. Hypothesis formulation (chapter 2), the empirical part of the thesis (chapter 3-4), results discussion and managerial implication (chapter 5) are rather weak. Conclusions of the thesis are poor.

The critical comments do not diminish the value of the master thesis, dedicated to actual and laborious topic. The research results generate the important issues for further discussions to find new ways how to use reverse logistics for manufacturing companies' management.

Page-by-page comments

It is not obvious what factors are significant for RL (chapter 2). Chapter 2 title is the same as the Master thesis title.

There are repetitions in Figure titles: (Figure 1, p.17; Figure 2, p.21, Figure 4, p.36, etc.)

Master thesis of Evgenia Belova meets the requirements of Master in International Business program, and deserves a "satisfactory" grade, thus the author can be given the desired degree.
