Additional comments:

The thesis in generally aimed at an interesting and trendy topic of open innovation with well-defined research framework. The literature overview is done in a good academic style. Language of the thesis is fluent. The quality of the thesis layout is rather professional but the structure is totally unbalanced thus theoretical introduction and literature overview cover almost one half (40 pages) of the whole volume. The chapter 3 has no subchapters at all and is only 4 pages long. Reliability and validity issues related to empirical study are not discussed but the overall impression of the thesis is positive.

Master thesis of Nina Aro meets the requirements of MIB program, and deserves a "good" grade, thus the author can be given the desired degree.
