Additional comments:

The strong points of the paper are: (1) good analysis of current world situation and trends in PPP, supported by recent statistics. (2) Comprehensive literature review. (3) Very valuable application of different PPT models to specific hospital — it actually can be used as complete and finished project on PPP financial modelling in the hospital #5.

Nevertheless, the paper is not free from certain weaknesses. First of all the description of current position of the hospital looks like the list of facts and numbers and is not accompanied by author's management analysis, thus the conclusion that PPP in the hospital #5 may result in performance improvement is not sufficiently substantiated. Second, the time horizon of modelling is not reasoned, though it has a dramatic impact on the option choice (I would add, that determining the right time of contract is the crucial part of any PPP project). The choice of preferential option based on discounted FCF only, seems insufficiently elaborated.

Despite the critical remarks the general impression of thesis is good and the author possessed required skills and competencies.

Master thesis of Kazimir Iablonskii meets the requirements of Master in Corporate Finance program, and deserves a **good** grade, thus the author can be given the desired degree.
