Regulatory sphere is one of the key aspects of pharmaceutical industry and has a great impact on industry performance. The regulatory environment is rapidly changing both on the country and regional levels especially in pharma and sometimes it is hard to keep track on it. The thesis gives an opportunity to understand and navigate it. It includes analysis of R&D and production pharma cycle. On the other hand, Anastasia chose very complicated and multi-dimensional topic. That is brave but the thesis lacks in-depth analysis due to too many different problems involved. Anastasia has done a great work describing Russian regulatory system and comparing it with other countries, making projections and recommendations about its future development. Unfortunately, the choice of countries for comparison is not justified properly and there are more relevant comparators in terms of healthcare systems. Anastasia collected and analyzed huge amount of data but the data presented contains some factual errors and outdated information, lacks understanding of market access processes and instruments. The recommendations made are very impressive but sometimes lack special knowledge (especially in pricing, financing of healthcare products and market access of health technologies) and are a little bit subjective. Nevertheless, the thesis gives an overview of the development of Russian pharma.

Master thesis of Anastasia Bogochanova meets (doesn't meet) the requirements of the Master in Public Management program, and according to the reviewer's opinion deserves a/an "excellent (A / B) / good (B / C / D) / satisfactory (D / E) / unsatisfactory (F)" grade, thus the author can be given the desired degree.
