Master thesis of Hunter Cawood refers to the relevant topic of investigation the factors hindering card payment adoption in Russia. Due to the extremely high speed of technological changes and financial innovations, the competitive advantages gathered by advanced card payments' usage become crucial.

Furthermore, the master thesis reviewed clearly defines tasks and objectives, so as methodology and study design, according to the research aim. The author presents a fresh view on the problem of achieving exact benefits come from card payments evolving in consumer purchases both for business and individuals, so as for the Russian economy. Sample data, presented in the master thesis, is well-quality collected throughout the author's adaptation of modern research approaches.

Master thesis of Hunter Cawood explores independent research attitudes to the newest studies in behavioral, financial, and managerial sciences, where the author processes sample data collected through his own designed survey questionnaire and econometric methods, particularly, linear regression and the least squares methods.

Also, to prolong the author's research, probably, will be grateful to disclose the extended study of the differences between savings and consumption, diversified for groups of variables explored in the master thesis reviewed. This could help in revealing the empirical impact of consumer behavior on card payments' usage in Russia withal to common behavioral heuristics such as framing (Kahneman and Tversky, 1979) and nudge (Thaler, 2017) significantly covered in the master thesis reviewed.

Meanwhile, the master thesis of Hunter Cawood contributes both to the theoretical background of the research topic and the improvement of managerial practices, primarily, in Russia. So, the study discloses that, initially, to enchance the economic outcome and the financial system's transparency, one needs to obtain non-cash electronic, especially, card payments' advantages first.

Master thesis of Hunter Cawood meets the requirements of the Master in Management Program, and according to the reviewer's opinion deserves an <u>excellent (A) grade</u>, thus the author can be given the desired degree.
