## **Additional comments:**

## Strengths:

- Relevant topic and interesting content;
- Structuredness of the text;
- The author used lot of relevant interesting resources (articles, books etc.);
- Practical orientation of master thesis.

## Weaknesses:

- Underestimated importance of corporate incubators / accelerators. In chapter 1 the author suggests a period in evolution "2000s nowadays: The current, third, period is represented by the wide use of a network model with a focus on external contacts and sources that the last could provide an access to (both in terms of knowledge, expertise, and funding). Characteristically also the popularization of private incubators." But it seems that in recent years innovation ecosystem has been changed significantly, corporate incubators / accelerators within big corporations are becoming the key players. Since big corporations often have their own knowledge management system (KMS), it must be taken into account when considering KMS within business incubators.
- Research of IT support for KM does not take into account online services for startups, which can be used for KM purposes: platforms for startups (AngelList, AngelCo, CПАРК, Indiegogo, Kickstarter etc.), which will monitor traction for startup and provide other services. Also IT support does not consider more advanced tools for capturing knowledge and analysis, e.g. artificial intelligence for gathering ideas, comparing them with patents etc.
- Small samples for survey and interviews, which set limitations for conclusions, framework development and further generalization of research results.

Master thesis of <u>Natalia Shakhova</u> meets the requirements of the <u>Master in Management</u> program, and according to the reviewer's opinion deserves a/an <u>good (D)</u> grade, thus the author can be given the desired degree.
