Noted advantages of work

The work is devoted to the poignant topic. The author used for analysis a large amount of information from official sources, professionally sorted out the problem, did a considerable amount of analytical work. There is not much graphic material - only two cards are presented in the work, but they are executed at a good level. One of the strengths of the work is that the author links the changes in the demographic situation in two constituent entities of the Russian Federation (St. Petersburg and the Leningrad Region) to the formation of the St. Petersburg agglomeration. He correctly notes that the change in the geodemographic situation in each of these subjects is primarily determined by the processes that take place on their border. At the same time, the key factor determining the geodemographic image of both entities is the development of agglomeration. Therefore, in order to prepare and justify management decisions, it is necessary to proceed from the patterns of development of the territorial geodemographic system "St. Petersburg - Leningrad region" as a whole. This valuable conclusion, obtained by the author, has considerable scientific and applied significance and can be used to justify the demographic and migration policy in St. Petersburg and the Leningrad region.

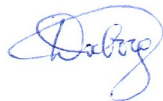
Reported deficiencies of work

There is a lack of literature sources in the work, theoretical and methodological bases of research are not disclosed, there is no comparison of the results obtained by the author with the works of other authors. It seems that the author left the theoretical chapter at the end and did not manage to fulfill it properly. This is the main lack of work, which does not allow you to evaluate the work on "Excellent". In addition, it was advisable to include more illustrative material in the work.

Reviewer's conclusion: The work can be evaluated with a "good" mark.
