## Additional comments:

The thesis under review examines the impact of corporate diversification on company performance and risk. First chapter offers a good overview of theoretical framework of diversification. Methodology described in the second chapter is well justified and clear, but certain assumptions would need some more justification. First, in this research author studied only "revenue diversification" companies, but in a reality company can diversify, for example, by collecting excessive currency (Surgutneftegaz), or by purchasing minority shares without revenue consolidation (ex. Rostelecom and Tele2). According to implied methodology this companies considered as non diversified, but in reality its well diversified. In the third chapter author conducted a good empirical study and determined a link between diversification and company perfomance and risk. But he didn't determined the "causality" of this link. So that's why the practical use of the results is limited. In this research author demonstrated a good knowledge of existing academic literature and good use of econometric instruments. The layout meets the requirements of the Regulations for master thesis preparation and defense, text is well structured, reader-friendly and clear.

Master thesis of Iskander Shagifullin meets the requirements of Master of Corporate Finance program, and according to the reviewer's opinion deserves a/an "excellent" grade, (ECTS grade is B) thus the author can be given the desired degree.

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
